"Pet Peeves" continue! Please all residents need to keep pets from urinating on shrubs, perennials, annuals and gardens, especially when using sidewalks.

Use less visible areas of our community such as wooded areas, and basin. Do not allow leashed dogs to walk into garden areas whether common or private areas. Keep pets from urinating in the same areas as it is not good for the grass, as evidenced by some burnt-out areas throughout the community.

Did you know:

Trash is allowed to be placed at curb, 6:00 PM the night before collection.

Speed limit in the community is 10 MPH.
